VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINES

Absentee Ballots: Call the Town Clerk 203 977 580

PRIMARY: Must be received 5th day before the primary if registering online or by mail. by 12 p.m. on the last business day before the primary if registering in person.

GENERAL ELECTION:

- 14th day before the election if registering online or by mail.
Or by the 7th day before the election if registering in person.
- If a Voter is registered with a party and, they want to change parties, they must do so 3 months prior to an election. If they are unaffiliated, they can change to a party affiliation 7 days in person at registrar's office.
- Connecticut now offers Election Day Registration. If you miss the registration deadline, you can register and vote in person on Election Day at the Government Center, 888 Washington Blvd, Stamford, CT

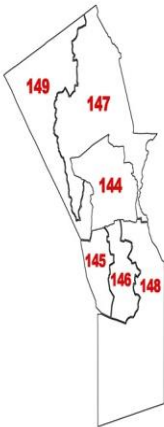

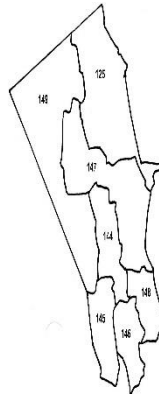

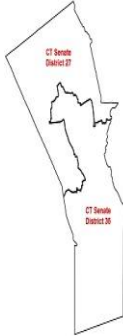
CURRENT HOUSE DISTRICTS



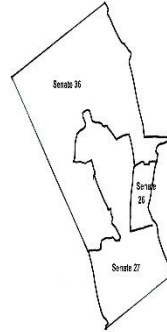
NEW HOUSE DISTRICTS (Voting 11/2022)
